# SERVICE PROCEDURE

#### Confirm Issue

- 1. Turn the ignition and the radio ON.
- 2. Push the MAP button so the current preset and radio station is displayed at the bottom of the screen as shown.

**NOTE:** SAT stations may display "NO SIGNAL" if the vehicle is indoors or has other signal obstruction.

- 3. While watching the display, press any preset button.
- 4. Watch the display for 3 seconds.
  - After 3 seconds, if the preset number is still visible as shown in Figure 1, that preset is OK.

**NOTE:** SAT stations may display "NO SIGNAL" if the vehicle is indoors or has other signal obstruction.

• If the preset number goes OFF as shown in Figure 2, the issue is confirmed and this bulletin applies.

Go to Correct / Restore Normal Preset Operation on the next page

- 5. Repeat step 3 and 4 for all presets (A, B, C / 1 through 6).
  - If all presets display as shown in Figure 1, this bulletin does not apply.

#### Explanation of Issue

If a radio station is preset in one city (example A3 preset to 102.9), and the vehicle is then driven to a different city that has a different radio station using frequency 102.9, when preset A3 is selected the preset number will go OFF as shown in Figure 2. This occurs because the radio recognizes that it is not the same radio station even though the frequency is 102.9. This condition will not occur for SAT stations.

## Correct / Restore Normal Preset Operation

- 1. Press the preset button for the incident preset (the one that dropped the number as shown in Figure 2).
- 2. Manually tune the radio to a different station.
- 3. Press and hold the same preset button so it becomes preset to a different station (the one you manually tuned).
- 4. Manually tune back to the desired station.
- 5. Press and hold the same present button again.
  - The issue is now corrected and all presets will scroll and function normally.

**EXAMPLE:** Preset A3 is tuned to frequency 102.9. When preset A3 is pressed, the 3 goes OFF as shown in Figure 2.

- a. Press preset A3 (radio is tuned to 102.9)
- b. Manually tune to 103.5
- c. Press and hold preset A3
- d. Manually tune back to 102.9.
- e. Press and hold preset A3
  - The issue is now corrected and all presets will scroll and function normally.
